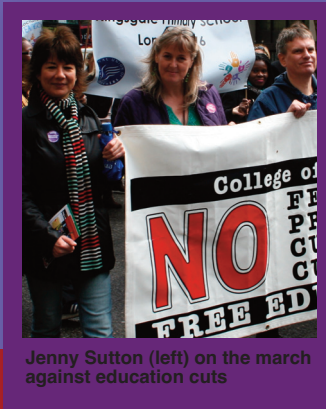


Save Education, Jobs and Public Services!
