



2014 elections: Regional breakdown of TUSC results North West Region

TUSC contested 16 councils in the North West with 52 candidates in 52 wards, all single-seat contests. These included four council by-elections in councils where there were no scheduled local elections. In addition, one of the candidates, Dawd Islam in Rochdale, who sought and was given endorsement by the TUSC steering committee, was approached to stand as a Respect candidate and, after local negotiations, appeared on the ballot paper under that registered party name.

Listed are the votes received by every candidate in these wards, with a percentage of the vote figure also given for the TUSC candidate. The political composition of each council before May 22nd is indicated in parentheses.
