



2014 elections: Regional breakdown of TUSC results Southern Region

TUSC contested seven councils in the Southern region with 38 candidates in 37 wards, with one two-seat contest. These included a by-election in Gravesham council where no local elections were scheduled.

Listed are the votes received by every candidate in these wards, with a percentage of the vote figure also given for the TUSC candidate. The political composition of each council before May 22nd is indicated in parentheses.
