



A directory of the elections taking place in May 2018

Local council elections will take place on Thursday May 3rd 2018 for all 32 London borough councillors, 34 Metropolitan borough councils, 17 unitary authorities and 68 second-tier district councils. Also on the same day there will be Mayoral elections in Watford and the London boroughs of Hackney, Lewisham, Newham and Tower Hamlets.

This directory, an annual production of TUSC which was referenced by the House of Commons Library in 2016, provides a breakdown of the councils being contested in May, the number of councillors up for election, and the current political control in each council listed.

The London borough elections are 'all-up' contests, with every councillor up for election, usually in multi-seat wards. Most other elections will be for one-third of the councillors in single-seat contests but there are ten councils – Leeds, Manchester, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, Hull, Eastleigh, Harrogate, Hastings, Huntingdonshire, St Albans and South Lakeland – which are holding 'all-up' elections following ward boundary changes.

In addition there are all-up elections in Birmingham and Newcastle-under-Lyme because, from 2018, they will be moving from annual to four-yearly elections 'to save money', a further erosion of local democracy. Both councils are currently controlled by right-wing Labour administrations.

In fact, since the equivalent point in the electoral cycle – in 2014 – ten councils have now moved to four-yearly elections and will therefore not go to the polls next year. These are Bristol, Doncaster, Rotherham, Bassetlaw, Stroud and Warrington (all Labour-led), and Gloucester, Hertsmere, West Lindsey and Stratford-on-Avon (Tory). Fear of the electorate, it seems, is further common ground between the Blairites and the Tories.

Of the 151 councils holding elections next May 86 are currently Labour-led, with Labour holding an overall majority or the largest party in a coalition administration; 56 have Tory-administrations, eight are Liberal Democrat-led and one council is headed by independents.

There are still ongoing boundary reviews to be factored but a current estimate is that next May will see 4,522 councillors elected in 2,748 wards.

And lastly the directory includes, from page nine, a list of 588 councillors who signed the Open Letter in support of Owen Smith's leadership coup against Jeremy Corbyn in the summer of 2016 who are councillors in local authorities with elections next May.

Not all of these councillors are necessarily up for election themselves – even if they haven't been deselected by their local party! – as many of them are in councils with 'one-third' contests in 2018.

But 288 are in councils with 'all-up' elections, so they will definitely be on the ballot paper in May 2018 if they are standing again. These include 239 councillors in the London boroughs, and 49 councillors across Birmingham, Hastings, Hull, Leeds, Manchester, Newcastle-upon-Tyne and Newcastle-under-Lyme.
