



2014 elections: Regional breakdown of TUSC results Eastern Region

TUSC contested eight councils in the Eastern region with 29 candidates in 28 wards, in three of which there were two councillors to be elected, and one with three.

Listed are the votes received by every candidate in these wards, with a percentage of the vote figure also given for the TUSC candidate (see Note on Statistical Methods on how this was calculated in multi-seat wards). The political composition of each council before May 22nd is indicated in parentheses.
