



A directory of local councils with elections on 7th May 2015 and parliamentary constituencies

The 2015 general election will take place on Thursday May 7th, on the same day as local council elections in 279 local authorities in England.

The general election will be fought in 533 parliamentary constituencies in England, 59 in Scotland, and 40 in Wales.

This directory comprises of two reports.

The first report is a profile of the councils being contested on May 7th, broken down into regions, with the number of councillors up for election in 2015 and the current political control in each council.

In total there will be 9,394 councillors elected in England next May, in 6,085 wards. For TUSC to contest one-sixth of these wards, the BBC's threshold for 'fair media coverage' from the broadcasting authorities, would mean a minimum of 1,015 candidates.

The second report is a regional breakdown of parliamentary constituencies grouped into local authority areas. These are the authorities where there will be local elections in 2015. The exceptions are the constituencies in Wales, Scotland and London, and in 32 English parliamentary constituencies in unitary county council administrative areas and a handful of shire districts as indicated where there are no local elections in this cycle.

For TUSC to contest one-sixth of the constituencies would mean 89 candidates in England, ten in Scotland and seven in Wales.



The 2015 elections: The council battlegrounds

Local elections will be held in 2015 on Thursday May 7th (the same day as the general election) in 279 local authorities in England and for the directly-elected mayors of Bedford, Leicester, Mansfield, Middlesbrough and Torbay.

Below is a profile of the councils being contested, broken down into regions, with the number of councillors up for election next year and the current political control in each council.

In total there will be 9,394 councillors elected in England next May, in 6,085 wards. For TUSC to contest one-sixth of these wards would mean a minimum of 1,015 candidates.

Of the 279 councils, 136 are Conservative controlled, 78 have a Labour majority, eight are led by the Liberal Democrats, and 57 are under no overall control.

The 2015 elections: Constituencies & councils

The 2015 general election will take place on Thursday May 7th, on the same day as local council elections in 279 local authorities in England.

Below is a regional breakdown of parliamentary constituencies grouped into local authority areas (in bold). These are the authorities where there will be local elections in 2015. The exceptions are the constituencies in Wales, Scotland and London, and in 32 English parliamentary constituencies in unitary county council administrative areas and a handful of shire districts where there are no local elections in this cycle (indicated in parentheses). For TUSC to contest one-sixth of the constituencies would mean 89 candidates in England, ten in Scotland and seven in Wales.

Where a constituency includes wards from two council areas it is listed in the council area which has the most wards in the constituency, with the council with the fewer number of wards indicated in parentheses.

The second column is the number of wards (and the percentage) contested by TUSC candidates in the 2014 local elections in the 'primary' local authority.
