



A directory of councils with elections on 2nd May 2024

Elections will take place on Thursday 2nd May 2024 for the Greater London Authority (Mayor and Assembly) and for 105 local authorities in England. Also on the same day will be city Mayoral elections in Liverpool and Salford and 'Metro-Mayor' elections for the combined authorities of Greater Manchester, the Liverpool City Region, North of Tyne, Tees Valley, West Midlands and West Yorkshire.

This directory, an annual production of the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition (TUSC), provides a breakdown by region of the councils being contested, with the number of councillors up for election and the current political control in each council listed. Of the 105 councils, 49 are Labour-led, 27 have a Conservative majority, nine are led by the Liberal Democrats, and 20 are under no overall control.

Most councillors will be elected in single-seat wards except in Bristol, Gloucester, Rotherham, Stroud and Warrington, which have a four-yearly electoral cycle; North Hertfordshire, which is moving to quadrennial elections from 2024; and Stevenage, with ward boundary changes.

The BBC sets a 'one-sixth' threshold for 'fair media coverage' from the broadcasting authorities so, it argues, 'a significant proportion of those watching or listening should have the opportunity to vote for the party concerned'.

There are still ongoing boundary reviews and re-organisation proposals to be factored but a current estimate is that around 2,040 councillors will be elected in May 2024. On that basis, to meet the BBC's 'fair coverage' criterion as applied to the total number of seats contested, would mean a minimum of 340 TUSC candidates would have to stand.

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The 2024 elections: The council battlegrounds
