



# Updated list: Where you can vote for anti-cuts, anti-war candidates on Thursday

While speculation mounts on whether Rishi Sunak could be forced into a summer poll, Thursday's local elections across England will give millions of people the opportunity to show what they think about all the establishment politicians. If you really do believe that it is time to vote for something different, why not start on May 2nd?

Below is a record of all the anti-cuts, anti-war candidates standing on May 2nd that the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition (TUSC) is aware of. They include the candidates appearing on the ballot paper under the TUSC name on Thursday, but also, from page eight, others – standing as independents, or for parties not yet part of the TUSC umbrella – who have been recommended for support for their anti-austerity, anti-war stance. ■

## The TUSC candidates in the May elections

Below is the list of the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition (TUSC) candidates standing in the local elections taking place on May 2nd.

There are 275 council candidates, contesting seats in 54 local authorities in England, presented in a regional breakdown, plus four constituency candidates for the Greater London Authority assembly and the Salford city mayor.

Out of the council candidates, 269 are standing in tier one or two local authorities with scheduled elections this year – 49 out of the 107 councils in that category. There is also one community councillor listed, seeking re-election in May. The remaining five candidates are contesting council by-elections that have been called to coincide with the May polls (indicated with an asterisk).

Overall, 13.8% of the council wards with local elections this year (264 out of 1,904, nearly one-in-seven) will have at least one TUSC candidate on the ballot paper, contesting 10% of the seats available, three times as many as in the 2023 local elections.

## Other anti-cuts and anti-war candidates standing on May 2nd

Listed below are the authority and ward details of 69 other stop the cuts and stop the war on Gaza council candidates standing in May's elections that TUSC is aware of, alongside two Combined Authority Mayoral candidates, one Police & Crime Commissioner candidate, and an alternative list for the London-wide members section of the Greater London Authority assembly. The most prominent contender included is Jamie Driscoll – regularly referred to in the establishment media as ‘the last Corbynista in office’ – who has a real prospect of becoming the Mayor of the new North East Combined Authority.

The list also includes the candidates of the Workers Party of Britain, led by the new Rochdale MP George Galloway, which has had observer status on the TUSC all-Britain Steering Committee since March 2022. The Workers Party has participated in all the discussions on that body but at this stage does not wish to take up full constituent status; which means having the right – but also the responsibility – to exercise a veto power over decisions to be made in the name of the coalition (the TUSC core policies, candidate approvals etc) under the TUSC ‘consensus rule’.

Other candidates include those from smaller left-wing parties which TUSC and its constituent organisations, locally and nationally, have attempted to liaise with to avoid electoral clashes: including the Communist Party of Britain, politically linked to the *Morning Star* newspaper, and Arthur Scargill's Socialist Labour Party. Some other parties in this category – specifically, the Breakthrough Party, Left Unity and the Northern Independence Party (which constituted the People's Alliance of the Left PAL group formed in 2021), and the more recently-established Transform Party launched in November 2023 – are not standing any candidates in May that we know of.

The last category on the list are candidates appearing on the ballot paper as Independents who have left the Labour Party in opposition to its general march to the right; or others, from a Labour background or not, who are standing in protest at the slaughter in Gaza. This is not by any means a full list of the 500 or so candidates appearing with the ‘Independent’ description in May's polls, which is used by individuals with an array of different political views. ‘Independents’, in fact, form the fourth largest group in UK local government, and where they control councils have acted no differently from establishment party politicians.



But the individuals listed here are those who have been recommended for support by local constituent organisations of TUSC and others – and in Coventry, Sheffield and Worcester with local TUSC candidates standing down in their favour – who could properly be described as anti-cuts and anti-war candidates even though, on this occasion, they have decided to stand as Independents. ■

As it is not obviously clear however whether someone could properly be described as an anti-cuts and anti-war candidate from the Independent description alone, TUSC contacted over thirty socialist parties and campaign groups, including the 'No Ceasefire, No Vote' network of ex-Labour councillors, asking them for details of any Independent candidates that they were supporting on May 2nd. There are likely to be more than just the 22 candidates below, but this is what we know of.
