We, the undersigned trade union members, declare our support for candidates at the general election supporting trade union and socialist principles at the ballot box.

The general election on 4th July will be a welcome chance for workers to end fourteen years of Tory rule. But Keir Starmer's New Labour clearly does not represent the interests of trade unionists. Starmer and Reeves' 'Labour's Plan to Make Work Pay' represents a further quashing of policies advanced under Jeremy Corbyn's leadership of the Labour Party - ultimately defending the right of employers to use fire and rehire, proposing a ban only on 'exploitative' zero hours contracts, and repealing only Tory anti-union laws dating back to 2016.

In Unite, general secretary Sharon Graham's words, "the number of caveats and get-outs means it is in danger of becoming a bad bosses' charter."

We think that trade unionists need our own political voice in the general election and beyond. We support candidates defending the basic principles of trade unionism and socialism, including independent candidates such as Jeremy Corbyn, in addition to candidates standing under the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition (TUSC) banner at this election.
